November 1, 2010 – April 30, 2011

The Hamilton Chapter hosted a very successful Annual Conference, November 4-5, 2010 with the theme *The Deeper Experience of Caring for Older Adults*. Keynote speakers, a panel presentation, and concurrent round table discussion/presentations made for a full day of knowledge exchange related to gerontological nursing. A highlight was the play on Thursday evening entitled *I'm Still Here* – a poignant and moving interpretation of the experience of living with cognitive impairment/Alzheimer's disease.

The Executive has met twice since the conference – in January and March 2011. The Chapter has held an education meeting in March on the topic of Regional Infection Control, and the resources available to staff working in various health care settings. Another education meeting is being planned for mid-June 2011, with an executive meeting immediately prior.
